<p>Science: Use of everyday materials</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -To be able to identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials, including wood, metal, plastic, glass, brick, rock, paper and cardboard 	<p>Art/DT:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Space collage
<p>History:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Neil Armstrong and Christopher Columbus 	<p>Computing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Using the internet safely - Typing - Researching famous explorers
<p>Geography:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The United Kingdom - Human and Physical features - Locating countries on a map 	<p>RE:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Hinduism
<p>P.E:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Basic ball skills. - Dance

The children will share their work in the class. - Number bonds or times tables and spelling tests will take place weekly. - Please read with your child every day.
