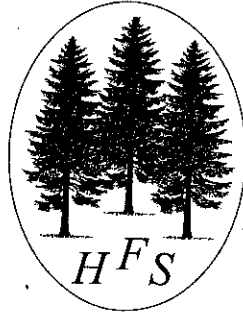

Dear Parent/Carers,

To support the Yr3 children's curriculum learning linked to the Romans, I am pleased to inform you that we have arranged for Class 3 to visit the Museum of Kent Life on Tuesday 24th April 2018, when they will have the opportunity to take part in several different workshops about Roman life, including:

- Make a Leather Amulet
- Graffiti Wall
- Life under the Romans
- Meet a Centurion
- Building a Better Britain
- The Celts and the Druids
- Meet Boudicca

To add further to the experience, all children (and staff!) are invited to come along dressed up as Romans for the day. We will however be outside for some of the day and so appropriate shoes and coats will still need to be worn.
