## **Lizzy Yarnold Victory Parade**

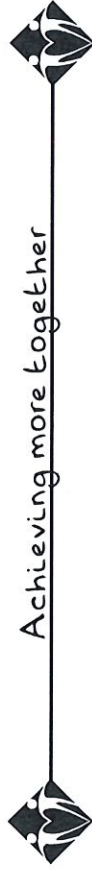
Lizzy Yarnold MBE, the double Olympic gold-medal winner, will be undertaking a victory parade in Swanley this Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> April. The parade route will come up London Road (from the M25 roundabout) before stopping at Swanley Market between 11am and 11.30am.

Due to the anticipated crowds and the large amount of adult supervision that would be required in order to safely take classes to see the parade we have decided that the school will only be able to take our Year 6 children as a class to participate in the event. The children will be supervised by staff and volunteers; they will be leaving from school at approx 10.30am and will return in time for normal lunch arrangements. We do need your consent for your child to participate in this event; if you agree to them taking part then please complete the adjacent slip by 9am on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> April.

Parents also have the option of taking their child to the parade themselves, particularly where they may be attending with siblings in other classes. In this instance, the children should be collected at 10.30am and returned to school by 12.15pm.
