## Lizzy Yarnold Victory Parade

Lizzy Yarnold MBE, the double Olympic gold-medal winner, will be undertaking a victory parade in Swanley this Wednesday, 18<sup>th</sup> April.

The parade route will come up London Road (from the M25 roundabout) before stopping at Swanley Market between 11am and 11.30am.

Due to the anticipated crowds and the large amount of adult supervision that would be required in order to safely take classes to see the parade we have decided that the school will only be able to take our Year 6 children as a class to participate in the event.

We do recognise, however, that this is a significant local event of exceptional circumstances and as such any parent who wishes to remove their child(ren) from other classes in school **from 10.30am to 12.15pm** in order to take them to attend the parade themselves may do so and they will receive an exceptional absence mark. Children attending should then return to have lunch at school and afternoon lessons as normal.
